Why Are These Important?

It is important to have correct tyre sizes for not only legal reasons, but also for your own safety and to ensure your car's speedometer is reading correctly and with accuracy. Using incorrect tyres may result in penalties from law enforcement/local authorities.



Tyre Pressures:

Tyre pressures are important for fuel economy, safety, and the environment. Running underinflated tyres will increase fuel consumption and cause longer braking distances which may prove an issue in high-risk situations. To combat this, it is recommended that you ensure your tyres are at correct pressures.

General advice recommends 30-34 PSI (2.06 to 2.34 BAR) all round on the car to resist all forms of usage from fully laden to normal use.

Use of Winter Tyres:

Unlike many continental European countries, it is not mandatory for winter tyres to be used in the UK. However, for greater traction, it is recommended. It is important to note that some insurance companies insist upon notification if a car they insure is being run with winter tyres. You **must** check with your individual insurance company to see if this is the case.
